Minutes of the Nordic Board for Wildlife Research 84th Board meeting (in Uppsala, Sweden, August 14th, 2007)

§1: The agenda was approved. However, due to time constraints, **it was decided** to postpone §2 to a later occasion.

§2: Postponed.

§3: The NKV-member fee for 2007 to NKV was mentioned and it was noted that neither Finland nor Sweden had paid yet. **It was decided** that the invoice for 2008 fee should be sent out early December. Further, Henrik informed about the current economical status.

The expected economical result for 2007 is around DKK 200.000:-, if no extra costs are added (However, see below §4).

§4: The never ending backlog in Wildlife Biology was discussed. **It was decided** that NKV will add an extra DKK 100.000:- to BioRed to momentarily and partly reduce the backlog.

§5: Pierre Migot informed about the French printing office EDP (Édition Diffusion Presse Sciences). However, even if several advantages could be seen with this solution, several steps remain before it is possible to take a decision. And most importantly, several important questions remain to be resolved. **It was decided** that Henrik Andrén together with Anne Loison and Tommy Asferg will go to Kalø during the autumn 2007 to clarify certain issues with Jan Bertelsen and BioRed. Further, **it was decided** that Henrik Andrén together with Jon Swenson, Michel Vallance and Anne Loison will go to EDP during the early spring 2008, to be able to inform the NKV-board in time for the next board meeting.

§6: The content of the home page was discussed. **It was decided** to make NKV-minutes official on the home page. In addition, the original document from 1971 where the Nordic Council decides about founding a “Nordic Board for Wildlife Research”, the Memorandum of Understanding and Order of business for the NKV Board should be available on the home page.

§7: **It was confirmed** that the next board meeting will take place in June 2-5, 2008 and that it will be held in France.
